How CSA Programs Work

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) shares give you a direct connection with our farm where your vegetables are grown and with the farmers who grow them. We give you fresh, delicious, organic produce throughout the growing season.

By buying shares of the future harvest while the ground is still frozen, you allow us to purchase the seeds and equipment needed in the spring. Once the season begins, usually by mid-June, we harvest fresh vegetables for you to enjoy each week, or bi-weekly if preferred, until mid-October. The produce available will change each week based upon what's in season.

Members thus agree to share the risks as well as the bounty of the harvest, allowing our farm managers to focus on growing.

That is what we do best!

In using farming practices that respect the land as a living entity we hope to create a better world for future generations.

Earth Haven's CSA program makes eating local affordable, convenient and satisfying. Our fresh and tasty organic produce is grown with utmost attention to nutritional value and agricultural integrity.

How Our CSA Program Works

Earth Haven Farm CSA program is a rewarding experience that includes a weekly or bi-weekly box of freshly harvested organic produce, containing 7 to12 items, depending on share size. Produce changes throughout the growing season.

Small Size - Suitable for a single person or couple with minimal produce requirements. The average worth of the small share size is \$24.50. 9 week bi-weekly program \$220 18 week weekly program \$440

Regular Size - Ideal for a vegetarian, a couple, or a small family. The average worth of the regular share size is \$34.50.

9 week bi-weekly program \$312

18 week weekly program \$624

Large Size - Ideal for families that love their greens, for vegetarians, juicers, cooks and people that like to entertain. Large share sizes can be preordered for specific weeks and would be worth \$44. (You would pay an extra \$10 for the share that week).

Value Added Additions

Over and above your CSA box, we offer the following items to you at an extra cost, pending availability. These items are paid for at time of pick-up or delivery.

Preserves, and frozen foods (excluding meat) may be ordered at a discounted price for CSA members starting from the day you receive your first CSA share until the day you receive your last CSA share. What is available will be posted on our website or you can inquire to info@earthhaven.ca

Like our many other customers, we invite you to feel free to order bulk produce when in season. Your weekly or bi-weekly box will allow you to know what we have. Feel free to order extra tomatoes, berries, greens, squash, potatoes, etc.

Grass Fed Beef - From purebred Scottish Highland Cattle who are 100% grass fed, free of hormones and antibiotics. We do not butcher on a regular basis, so meat is not always available and, when it is, it is in high demand. Quantities and cuts of meat are limited.

Our seedling sale returns this year with organic starts for your garden. Stay tuned to dates and times when the seedlings will be available. You can preorder your seedlings by contacting Aric or Emily at info@earthhaven.ca
